Privacy Policy

Protecting your private information is our priority. This Statement of Privacy applies to thewww.stxca.com/ and governs data collection and usage. For this Privacy Policy, unless otherwise noted, all references to STXCA including www.stxca.com/ website is an information and signup site. By using the STXCA website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Collection of your Personal Information

STXCA may collect personally identifiable information, such as your name, Date of birth, current and previous addresses, and other relevant information related to the restoration and repair of your credit report by removing inaccurate negative items. STXCA may also collect anonymous demographic information, which is not unique to you, such as your age, city and state. We may gather additional personal or non-personal information in the future. Information about your computer hardware and software may be automatically collected bySTXCA. This information can include your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring website addresses. This information is used for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the STXCA website.

STXCA encourages you to review the privacy statements of websites you choose to link to from STXCA so that you can understand how those websites collect, use and share your information. (STXCA) is not responsible for the privacy statements or other content on websites outside of the STXCA website.

Use of your Personal Information

STXCA collects and uses your personal information to operate its website(s) and deliver the services you have requested.

STXCA may also use your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from STXCA and its affiliates.STXCA may also contact you via surveys to conduct research about your opinion of current services or of potential new services that may be offered.

STXCA does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties.

STXCA may share data with trusted partners to help perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to STXCA, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

STXCA may keep track of the websites and pages our users visit within STXCA in order to determine what STXCA services are the most popular. This data is used to deliver customized content and advertising within STXCA to customers whose behavior indicates that they are interested in a particular subject area.

STXCA will disclose your personal information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on STXCA site; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of STXCA and, (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of STXCA, or the public.

Use of Cookies

STXCA website may use “cookies” to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize STXCA pages, or register with STXCA site or services, a cookie helps STXCA to recall your specific information on subsequent visits. This simplifies the process of recording your personal information, such as billing addresses, shipping addresses, and so on. When you return to the same STXCA website, the information you previously provided can be retrieved, so you can easily use STXCA features that you customized.

You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. Most Web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer.
